1st ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

MINUTES

The 1st Administrative Committee Meeting was held on 27 October 2006 in İstanbul- Turkey under the Presidency of Mr. Sezai Bağbaşı. The following countries participated in the Meeting: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Greece, Romania, Russian Federation, Ukraine and Turkey. The decisions taken are the following:

1. The Member of the Administrative Committee from Greece, Mr. Thomas Mendesides and the Member of the Administrative Committee from Russian Federation Mr. Nikolai Borovkov were selected as Vice Chairs.
2. The Emblem of the Games will be approved in the next Administrative Committee Meeting.
3. One member from different representative country will be selected to be responsible for each Committee related to the Discipline, Anti-doping, Referee and Legal, according to the 6th article of the Statute. Romania was volunteer to be responsible for the Referee Committee as well as Georgia was volunteer to be responsible for Anti-doping Committee and both of them were approved with unanimity. The Referee Committee will cooperate with International Federations of the respective sports in order to define the appropriate referees.
4. The proposed dates (from 02 to 08 July 2007) by the Organizing Committee were approved by the Administrative Committee.
5. The 9 disciplines proposed by the Organizing Committee were approved. There were further discussions on the possibility of the lack of national participation of the countries in all disciplines. For this reason, it was decided that the countries should send their confirmation regarding their national teams' participation before the next Administrative Committee Meeting.
6. The age groups of the disciplines will be defined according to the age limits of each International federation taking into consideration the junior level.
7. The participants will pay 105 \$ per person for the whole period (7 days) of the Games. The expenses of the Referees, members of the Administrative Committee and the Ministers of the member countries will be covered by the host country during their stay.
8. Number 1 of the logos proposed by the Organizing Committee was selected as the Logo of the Games. The symbol "anchovy" was also approved.
9. Regarding the doping control, the doping samples could be taken randomly from 3 athletes in team sports and from the first 3 ranked athletes in individual sports.
10. Doping samples will be tested in WADA accredited Hacettepe Laboratory.

11. The advertisements on the T-shirts of the athletes will be according to the International Federations' rules. The National Organizing Committee will be able to use the commercial advertisements. However, alcohol or cigarette advertisements and the ones carrying political messages are prohibited.
12. The next Administrative Committee Meeting will be held in Trabzon-Turkey in the second half of February 2007. The precise dates will be communicated to the members of the Committee in due time.
13. The file prepared by the Organizing Committee was approved and signed as it is.
